proportional: to keep the same ratio between objects.

idle: lazy.

Humphrey Newton: (? - ?) an assistant to Isaac Newton, although they shared the same last name they were not related.

catalyst: something that causes change.

plague: a fatal, epidemic disease.

refracted: bent, deflected from a straight path.

Galileo Galilei: (1562-1642) Italian astronomer and physicist.

accelerate: to speed up, to increase in velocity.

inertia: the property that keeps an object at rest.

mass: the amount of material that makes up an object.

Johannes Kepler: (1571-1630) German astronomer and mathematician.
